Why is Lung Cancer Screening Important?

Just like we want to fix a leaky roof in our house before it gets worse, doctors want to find and help get rid of any sneaky visitors (or health concerns) in our lungs before they can cause big problems. Lung cancer screening helps doctors catch things early before symptoms start so they can be taken care of and not cause trouble.

A picture of your lungs with a low dose CT is the best way doctors can screen for health concerns. Your doctor knows making time to get this done can be difficult. If you have not had a CT scan of your lungs this year, your doctor has an **easy** first step to do **today**!



FirstLook is a simple blood test that helps doctors decide if they need to get a picture of your lungs.



Simple Process

Routine blood draw takes less than 1 minute



Results Returned

Test results are returned to your doctor in 10-14 days



Next Steps

This test does not diagnose cancer. The results (Elevated or Not Elevated) help your doctor decide if they want to get a picture of your lungs with a low dose CT now or if they can wait.



Annual Screening

To ensure your lungs stay strong and healthy, your lungs must be checked every year.



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
